


Symptoms: Drooling, headshaking, diarrhea, vomiting


Poisonous Part: Entire plant Symptoms:

Abnormal heart rate, diarrhea, drooling, temporary blindness, seizures, coma




Poisonous Part: Entire plant Symptoms:

Poisonous Part: Entire plant Symptoms:


Drooling, vomiting, difficulty breathing dilated pupils, seizures, death

Profuse drooling, vomiting, diarrhea, rapid heart rate, trouble breathing




Poisonous Part: Entire plant Symptoms:

Burning of lips and mouth, salivation, nausea, severe vomiting, coma, and death



Poisonous Part: Entire plant Symptoms:

Vomiting, diarrhea, cramps, irregular heartbeat, labored breathing, convulsions, death




Poisonous Part: Leaves Symptoms:

Vomiting, diarrhea, spasms, paralysis

Rapid pulse, dermatitis, disorientation, liver and kidney damage




**Poisonous Part:** Leaves Symptoms: Vomiting, respiratory failure, abnormal heart rate




**Poisonous Part:** Entire plant Symptoms: Diarrhea, liver failure, death




**Poisonous Part:** Entire plant Symptoms: Vomiting, diarrhea, and tremors




**Poisonous Part:** Entire plant Symptoms: Severe diarrhea, slow heart rate
